EXAM SCHEDULE/ ASSESSMENT STRUCTURE /PATTERN FOR CLASS-III - VIII

ASSESSMENT PATTERN- Session 2019-20 onwards

1. There will be a new model of progress report cards for classes III to VIII.
2. The marks and grades both will be reflected in all the classes.
3. For classes III to VIII, the pattern of assessment given by CBSE for classes VI-VIII, will be implemented having two terms i.e. 1st term and 2nd term. However, both the terms will be treated separately without including portion of the 1st term in the 2nd term (**Annexure-C**).
4. Nomenclature of the examination for both the terms will be **Half-Yearly Examination** and **Yearly Examination**. The scheme of CBSE given in Circular No.: Acad-14/2017 dated 21.03.2017 regarding Uniform System of Assessment, Examination and Report Card for classes VI-IX from academic session 2017-18 onwards will be followed (**Annexure-B**).
5. All tests/examination in class III to VIII will have assessed separately (**not on cumulative content**).
6. **HALF-YEARLY/YEARLY EXAMINATION:** For Class III-V, the question papers of **Half-Yearly Examination** would be set out of the syllabus supposed to be covered up to the **30th September** of the Academic Year and the **Maximum marks of subjects will be 60**.

The question papers of the **Yearly Examination** for **class III to V** would be set out of the Second Term syllabus i.e. syllabus covered after Half-Yearly examination to Yearly Examination and the **Maximum marks of subjects will be 60**.

For Class VI - VIII - The question papers of **Half-Yearly Examination** of classes VI to VIII would be set out of the syllabus supposed to be covered up to the **30th September** of the Academic Year and the Maximum marks of subjects will be 80.

The question papers of the **Yearly Examination** for **class VI to VIII** would be set out of the Second Term syllabus plus 10% to 30% syllabus of the First Term (increasing progressively from Classes VI to VIII). i.e.

Class VI: 10% of 1st term covering significant topics + entire syllabus of 2nd term.

Class VII: 20% of 1st term covering significant topics + entire syllabus of 2nd term.

Class VIII: 30% of 1st term covering significant topics + entire syllabus of 2nd term.

7. PERIODIC TESTS:

For class III to VIII, **One Periodic Test** (of 40 marks) will be conducted before the Half-Yearly Exam. This Periodic Test will cover syllabus supposed to be covered up to the Periodic Test I (up to 31st July). The **Second Periodic Test** (of 40 marks) will be conducted before the Annual Examination. This Periodic Test will cover syllabus supposed to be covered after Half-Yearly Examination to the Periodic Test II. 40 marks of the Periodic Test will be converted into 10 marks for the purpose of Half-Yearly and Annual Exam.

8. **Notebook Submission** 05 marks at term end + **Sub Enrichment Activity** 05 marks at term end will be evaluated for class III to VIII.
9. In classes III-VIII, the student scoring E grade in Half yearly and yearly Examination can be given one opportunity to improve their performance in half-yearly and Yearly examination **separately**.
10. The co-scholastic activities for all classes will be graded term wise on a **three-point** grading scale as given by CBSE Circular No.: Acad-14/2017 dated 21.03.2017.
11. **COMPUTER, ARTS/CRAFTS/PAINTING, MUSIC, YOGA, G.K. etc.** will be assessed in co-scholastic areas.
